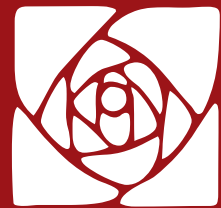


Making A Roycroft Cylinder Vase

What's Included:

- Instruction for Process & Design with Master Artisan Ron VanOstrand
- Material to make a 2" x 7" Vase
- Three Custom Chasing Tools
- A Custom Metal Forming Stake
- Limited Small Class Size (6 person Max)
- Consumables (torch fuel, sand paper, hearing protection, patina solution etc.)

Students are responsible for their own food & lodging



Ron is often asked to teach the skills needed to craft cylindrical vases, but the facilities available locally have not been available until now for a class with a project this involved.

Learn how to craft a seven inch tall, two inch diameter cylinder vase and leave with some specialized tools needed to complete the task on your own for the future. Tips for chasing & planishing on a curved surface, design layout and transfer, crafting of a bottom insert, soldering techniques for vase bottoms, and flaring of tube forms are some of the intermediate level skills that will be covered. Alternate techniques will also be discussed and demonstrated. Students may design their own or use a pre-made layout. Additional instruction time in studio is available if desired Monday & Tuesday for an additional fee.
